#### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION (INDICATE IF ORAL OR POSTER)

All abstracts should be single-spaced, font size 12, Times New Roman. Abstracts to follow the order -

**Title:** 15 words or fewer (use upper-case letters only for the first word and names);

**Author(s) details (name and affiliation):** First name, initial, followed by surname. Institution of affiliation; The first author is the presenting author; The body of the text should be no longer than 200 words and should include;

**Background:** The primary objectives of the study;

**Methods:** Should include design, methods of data collection and analysis;

**Findings:** Should include a summary of the results (accompanied by important statistical information), description of the main findings;

**Discussion:** Conclusions and/or some discussion of the possible contribution to, or implications of the findings.

Power Point for oral presentations are to be submitted alongside abstracts

Dimension for Poster Presentations: 90cm (width) x 100cm (height)

Abstract Handling Charge: N2, 500
